

## Count Off, Squeak Scouts!

Printable Activity Page 1

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### SQUEAK SCOUTS IN ORDER

#### Line Up the Mice!

- ▶ Print page 2 and cut out the ten squeak scouts. You will use the five mice with names on their pants first. Set aside the five mice without names for use with the Bonus Activity on this page.
- ▶ Remind children that before the mice went to the attic, the scout leader Agnes had them line up in order and call out their numbers.
- ▶ Point out the names of the mice on the mice's pants. Say: *As I say the name of the first mouse, place that mouse on the first line. As I say the names of the other mice, place those mice on the lines in order across the page.*
- ▶ Slowly read the name of each mouse on page 10 of *Count Off, Squeak Scouts*.
- ▶ When children have placed all five mice on the lines, ask: *Who is number 1? Write a number 1 on Rachel's shirt. Who is number 2? That's right! It's Albert. Write a number 2 on Albert's shirt. Continue with all five mice.*

#### Count Off the Mice

- ▶ Have children glue or tape their mice to the page.
- ▶ Then have them count off aloud from 1 to 5.

#### BONUS

Ask: *What if five more mice wanted to join Albert and his friends? Have children line up the five additional mice below the row of Albert and his friends. Point to the first mouse and ask: What number is this mouse? That's right. It's 6. Continue with the other mice. Then have children write the numbers on the new mice and count off all the mice from 1 to 10.*



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# HELP ALBERT NUMBER HIS SOUVENIRS!

For each child you will need:


-  A copy of pages 4 and 5
-  A crayon or marker
-  Glue or a glue stick

### Help Albert With His Souvenirs!

- ▶ Copy pages 4 and 5, and cut out Albert's souvenirs.
- ▶ Remind children that Albert has a large collection of souvenirs. He decides to number the things in his collection. He numbers his favorite souvenir with the number 1. He numbers his next favorite thing with the number 2.
- ▶ After that, Albert can't decide how to number his souvenirs. You need to help him.

### Number and Order the Souvenirs

- ▶ First put Albert's favorite souvenir, numbered 1, on the first line in the first row on page 5. Then put his second favorite on the second line in the row after his favorite.
- ▶ Look at the rest of Albert's souvenirs. Decide which ones you like and number them from 3 to 10. As you number each souvenir, place it in order after the last one in the row.
- ▶ Have you ordered all of Albert's souvenirs from 1 to 10? Read the numbers aloud to be sure you have them in the correct order
- ▶ Glue or tape Albert's souvenirs in order on the page. (Children will have 2 rows of 5.)



Share your page of numbered and ordered souvenirs with a friend or family member. Tell what each souvenir is and read the numbers in order. If you could choose your favorite souvenir, what would it be?


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# Count Off, Squeak Scouts!

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## UNSCRAMBLE THE SQUEAK SCOUTS

- ▶ Print this page and have children count off the mice at the bottom of the page from 1 to 5. Then cut out the five squeak scout mouse cards.
- ▶ First have children place their mouse cards faceup on a desk or table and mix them up. Then have children arrange the mouse cards in order from 1 to 5 using the numbers printed on the mice's shirts.
- ▶ Then have children turn their mouse cards facedown and mix them up again. Have them turn over one mouse card at a time and put the mouse cards in order from 1 to 5.
- ▶ Finally, have children order the mouse cards in reverse order. They should arrange the cards from 5 to 1.

### Bonus

Children might enjoy taping or gluing the five mice onto popsicle sticks. They could use them to reenact the story as you reread *Count Off, Squeak Scouts*. They could also take their mice on their own adventure throughout their home or classroom. Encourage children to "Count Off" as they go on their adventures.
